

2024 Mitchell-Beall-Rosen Scholarship Contest Concludes

At the conclusion of its 2024 Mitchell-Beall-Rosen Memorial Scholarship Contest, NASA Federal Credit Union awarded \$35,000 in scholarships—ranging from \$2,000 to the top prize of \$9,000—to six high school seniors. The annual program rewards the writing talents of young Credit Union members who are working toward four-year or two-year undergraduate degrees or vocational studies. Students submit 1,000-word essays that focus on their educational goals and financial literacy as it applies to the cost of a college education and their plans for paying it.

"As in prior years, I am humbled by the accomplishments of our scholarship winners," said Dr. Alotta Taylor, Chairperson of NASA Federal's Scholarship Committee. Protect Yourself from Financial Scams

Financial scams are on the rise and being informed is your first line of defense. Here's what you need to know to keep your financial and personal information safe from fraudsters.

Common Types of Financial Scams

Phishing Scams: These scams involve fraudulent emails, texts, or websites designed to steal your personal information. They often appear to be from legitimate sources like banks or credit unions.

Identity Theft: This occurs when someone uses your personal information, such as your Social Security number or bank details, to commit fraud or theft.

Online Shopping Scams: Scammers create fake websites or online listings to trick you into paying for goods or services that don't exist.

Investment Scams: Fraudsters offer fake investment opportunities, promising high returns with little risk, to steal your money.

Imposter Scams: Scammers pose as trusted individuals or organizations, such as government agencies, to trick you into giving them money or personal information.

Protect Yourself

Stay Informed: Regularly educate yourself about the latest scams. NASA Federal Credit Union provides updates on common scams and security tips through our website and newsletters.

Verify Communications: If you receive a suspicious email or message claiming to be from NASA Federal Credit Union or any other institution, do not click on any links or provide personal information. Contact the institution directly using their verified phone number or website.

Secure Your Information: Keep your personal and financial information secure. Use strong, unique passwords for your online accounts and change them regularly. Enable two-factor authentication (2FA) where possible.

Monitor Your Accounts: Regularly check your bank statements and credit reports for any unauthorized transactions. Set up alerts for your accounts to notify you of any unusual activity.

Beware of Public Wi-Fi: Avoid accessing your financial accounts over public Wi-Fi networks, which can be insecure. Use a virtual private network (VPN) if you need to use public Wi-Fi.

Be Skeptical of Unsolicited Offers: If something sounds too good to be true, it probably is. Be wary of unsolicited offers or requests for money or personal information.

Report Suspicious Activity: If you suspect you're a victim of a scam, report it immediately to NASA Federal Credit Union and the relevant authorities. Quick action can help prevent further loss.

Educate Your Family: Scammers often target vulnerable individuals, such as the elderly. Educate your family and friends about common scams and encourage them to be cautious.
